

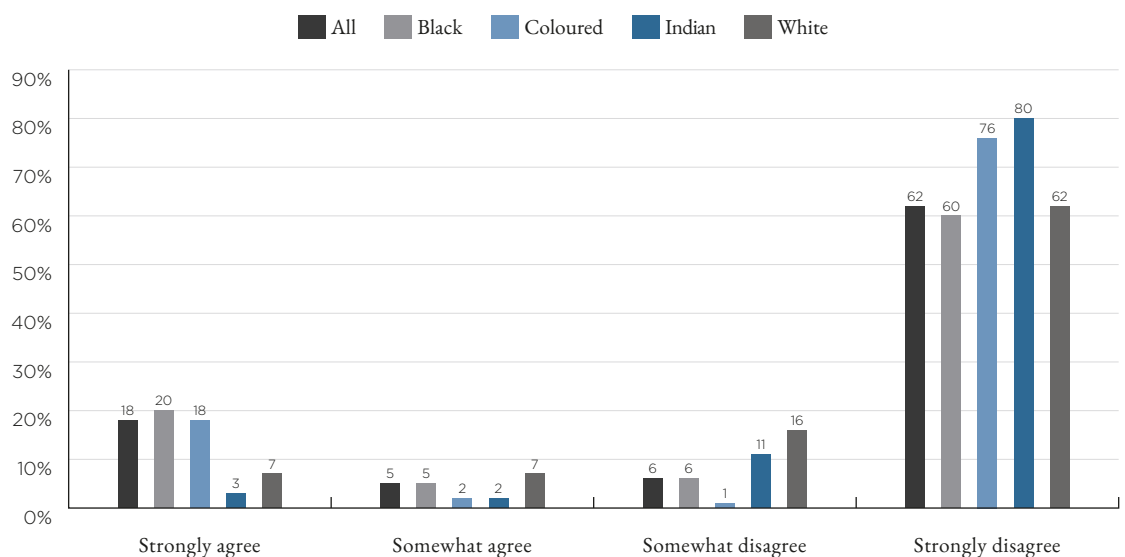
# SOUTH AFRICAN VOTERS’ PERCEPTION OF TRANSGENDERISM

**This report investigates the perception of registered South African voters towards transgenderism.**

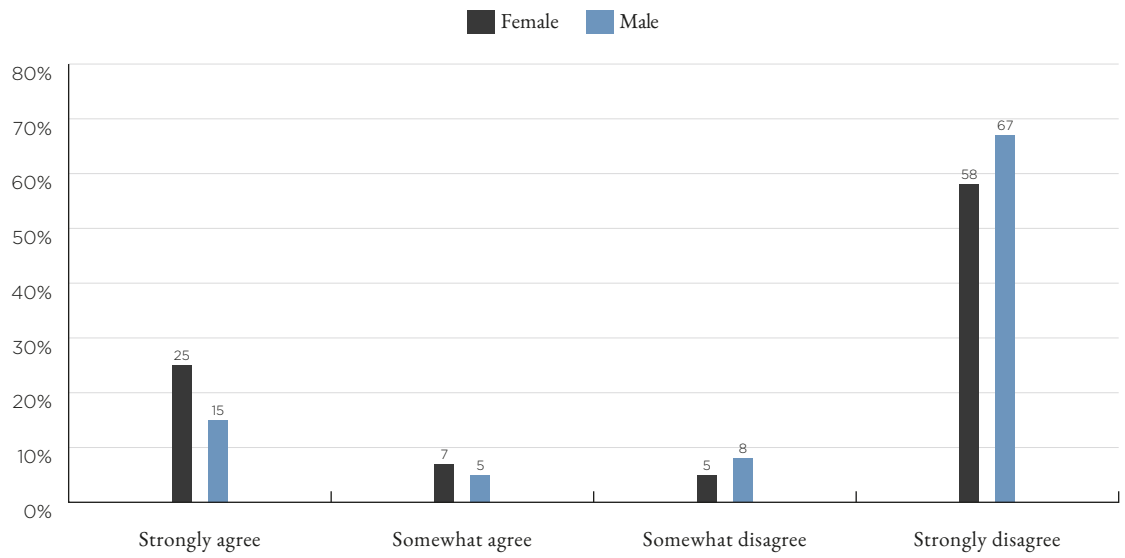
The data is based on a survey of 1 412 geographically and demographically representative registered voters commissioned by the Foundation in October 2023. That survey had a national margin of error of 5%. Totals may not add up to 100% where rounding has occurred or where participants refused to answer a question.

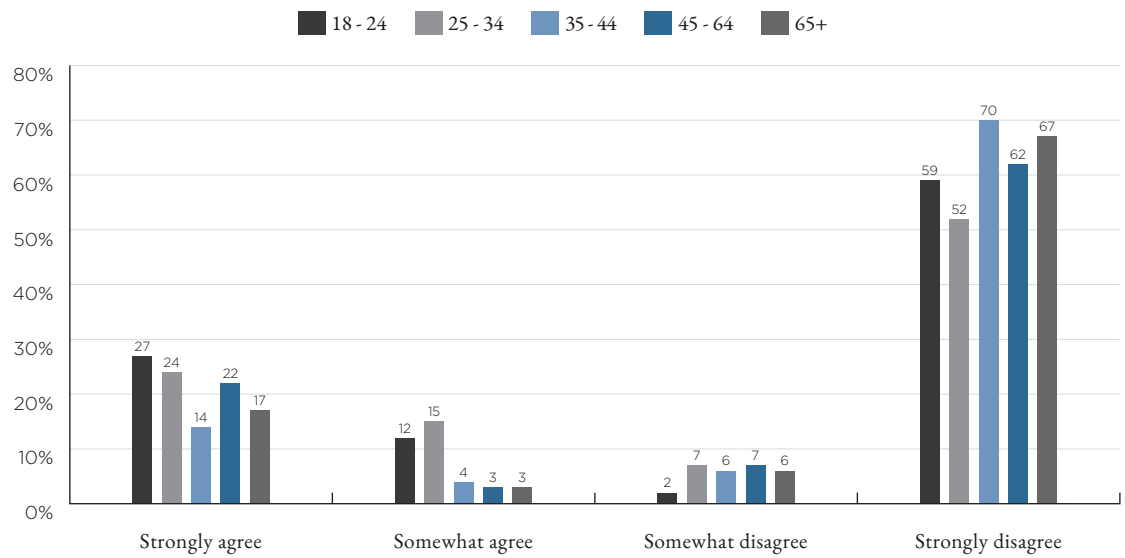
By race



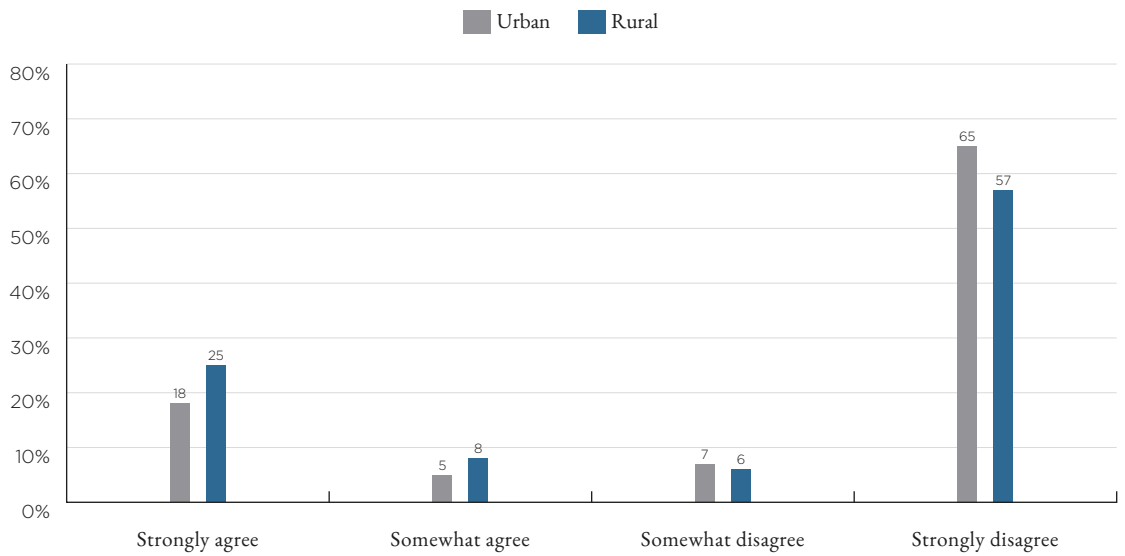
## By gender



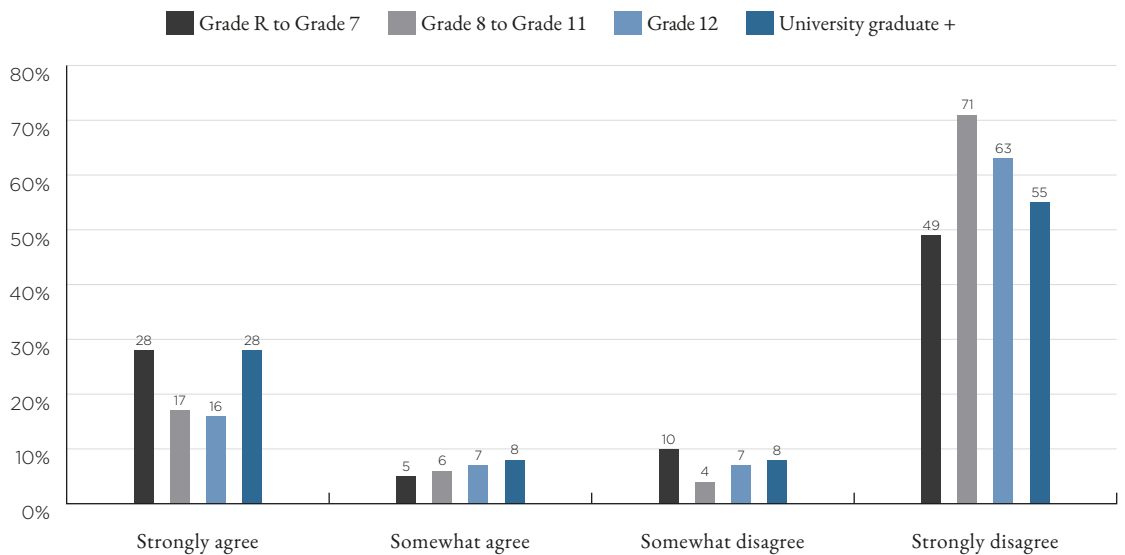
## By age



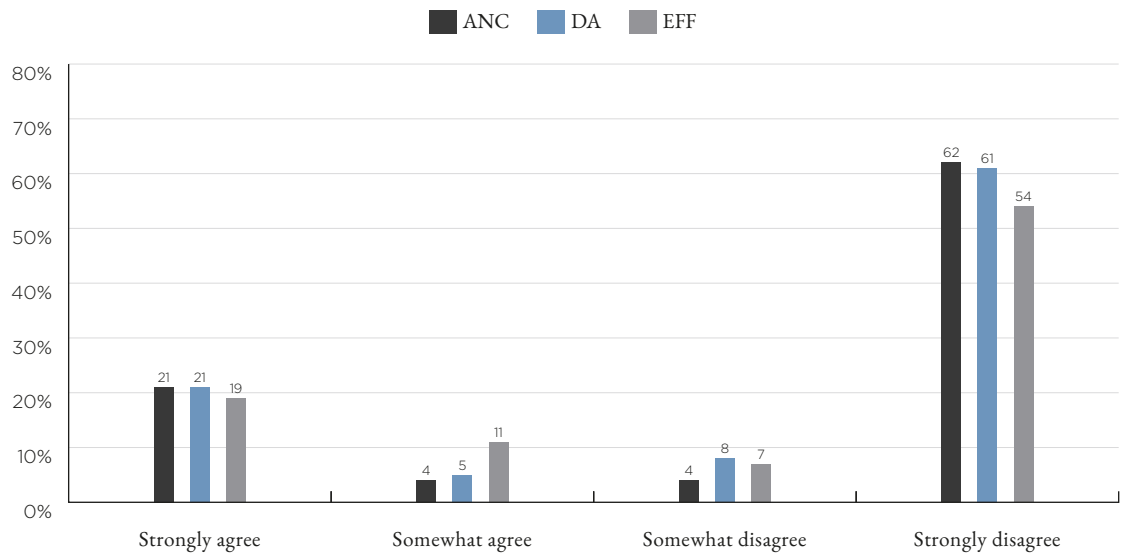
### By residential area

## TENTATIVE CONCLUSIONS

The data suggests that two thirds of registered voters may be hostile to the idea of a person changing their gender and then utilizing the bathrooms of the opposite gender.
